

2009 Examination Enrolments in WA

Cancellations and Transfers

No refunds will be given in the case of cancellations. Once enrolment has been made, a transfer may only happen subject to space availability and payment of the transfer fee.

Candidates who are unable to present themselves for their exams must notify the AMEB forthwith, and at least 48 hours before the exam in order to be eligible for transfer concessions.

Where a cancellation is undertaken on medical grounds, a credit note for half the grade fee will be issued if a current medical certificate [max. 2 weeks old] is supplied to the AMEB office within five (5) working days of the exam date.

A medical transfer is charged the same as a grade transfer. (Refer to Service Charges)

Transfers from one examination year to the next are not possible.

Complaints

All complaints must be lodged in writing and include a copy of the report form.

Reassessment

Reports submitted for reassessment must be accompanied by a reassessment fee of \$37. Reassessment applies to completed reports only, and does not constitute resitting the exam.

The details you provide on the enrolment form will appear on all AMEB documentation including the certificate. It is the responsibility of the person making the enrolment to check that all the following details are correct:

Preferred week for examination – Week number only (specific days/dates/ times entered in place of a week number will not be accepted).

The Candidate's Date of Birth forms part of the Candidate Number, and assists the AMEB in allocating appropriate examiners. It also provides the AMEB with statistical information necessary to better adapt its services to market needs.

Teachers must, when making entries, ensure that candidates are available anytime in the selected week. Requests cannot be guaranteed. Transfer charges remain the responsibility of the person making the enrolment.

Late Enrolments

Enrolments made later than the published closing date may still be accepted subject to space availability and payment of the stipulated late fee (\$30 per candidate). For enrolments by mail, the postmark will be taken as the day of enrolment. The AMEB will not be held responsible for delays of enrolments forwarded by mail, or other delays outside its control including the non-arrival of faxed enrolments, and no discussion will be entered into.
