**SCALES in ONE POSITION:** Prepare major *and* harmonic minor, with one bowing only.

**DOUBLE STOPS:** Circle your choice: [N.B. 6ths one octave only]

3rds & 6ths      3rds & 8ves      6ths & octaves      Circle bowing [i] or [ii]

1. [Scales on one string]. Prepare two, one major and one melodic minor, one open string, one first finger. *Examiner will choose the string to play on. You choose the fingerings.*

2. Prepare on all strings. *Examiner will choose the string to play on.*

3. Circle your chosen key: G major or D major
