CHROMATIC SCALE starting on.....

DOMINANT & DIMINISHED 7ths: Play both in succession *Examiner chooses starting note*

ONE STRING SCALES: Play major then minor without stopping *Examiner chooses starting note*

SCALES IN ONE POSITION (for option [b] only): *Candidate chooses one bowing. Examiner chooses major or minor.*

DOUBLE STOPS: Prepare all with one bowing only. *Examiner chooses keys.*

EXERCISES:

1. *Candidate chooses the strings.....*

2. *Candidate chooses the key. Circle A or E major. Choose four bowing patterns only. Circle the 4 examples you have chosen from a,b,c and d*

a[i] or a[ii] b[i] or b[ii] c[i] or c[ii] d[i] or d[ii]

3. *Candidate chooses the string. Examiner chooses a 1st or 2nd position starting note.*
